### **ELMVALE & MIDHURST ARE OPEN**

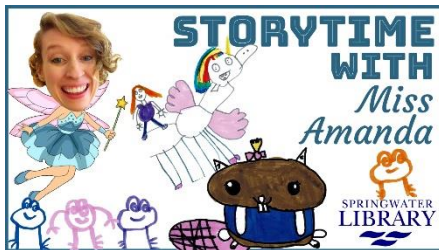
We are open at the Elmvale and Midhurst Branch.

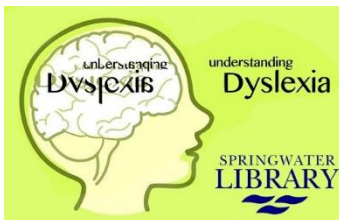


### **LEGO BUILDING CHALLENGE**
