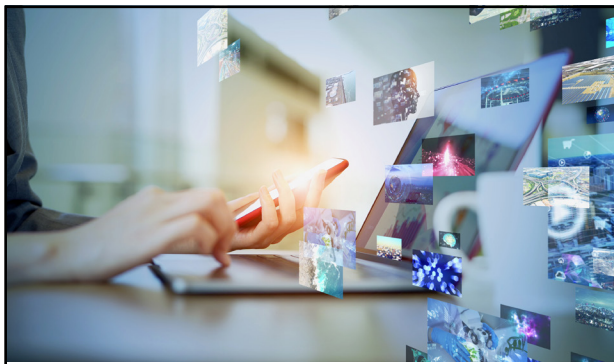

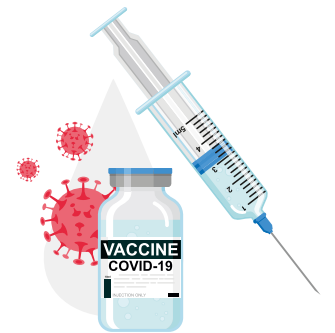
Elmvale Blood Drive

Exemptions:

- Youth under 18Y who are actively participating in sport
- Those with a written medical exemption from vaccination

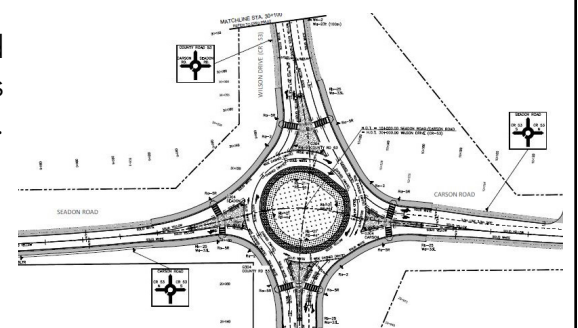


County Road 53 Roundabout Project

As of September 22, 2021, you must be fully vaccinated and provide proof of vaccination to access certain indoor businesses and settings.
